Although for the first time, outside spaces were safer than inside. Therefore removing the boundary of the project helped us to create the urban void which made the customers feel safer to get into the café.

Moreover, having the walls installed in a way to contain people's peripheral needs, such as paper towels, disinfectants, spoons, forks etc. helped the users feel clean to take their needs by their own hands. So everybody felt relaxed and joyful to stay and experience this space.
