WEST ELEVATION

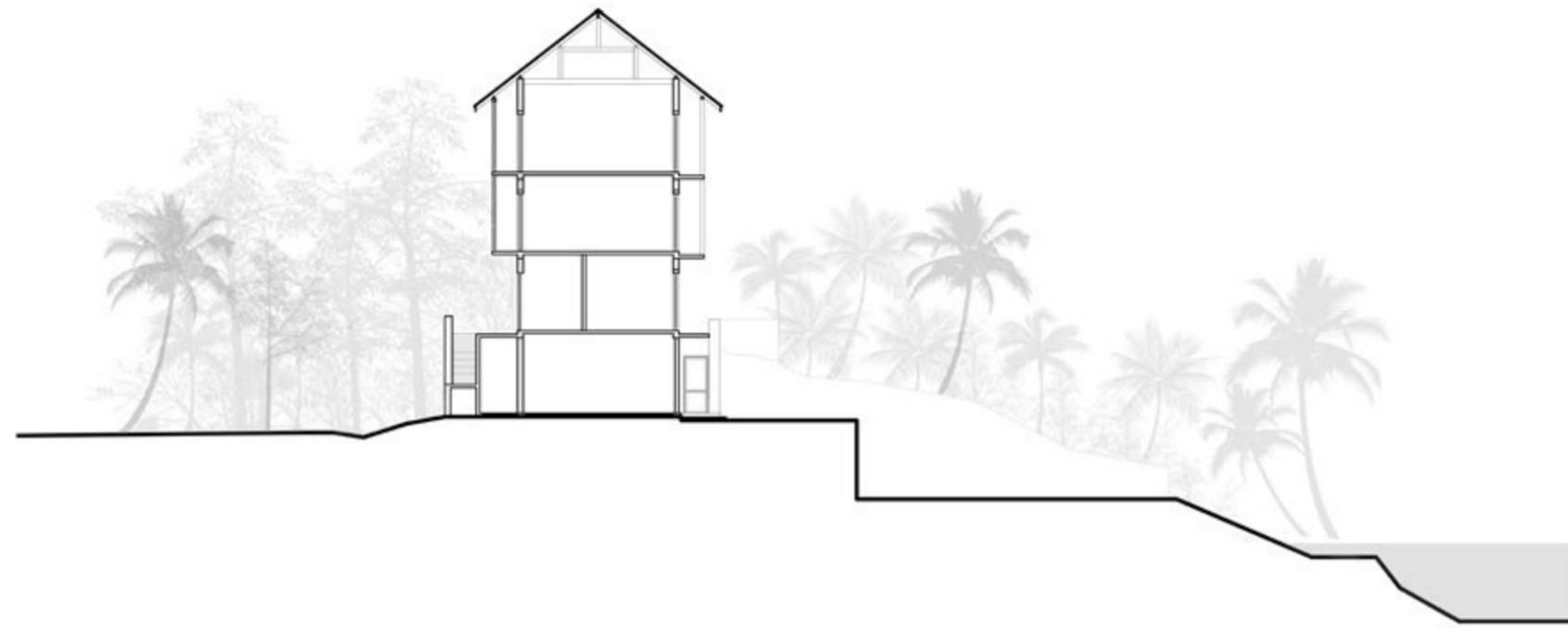


Scenic.
